Mission Statement

The purpose of the NMSU Rec-Sports Camp is to provide a sports and development experience for boys and girls ages 5 to 12 years-old. The intended purpose of the camp is to develop a wide variety of fundamental physical activity skills that are inherent to a healthy lifestyle and a lifetime of physical fitness.

Sports Camp Structure

Camp programs for 5 to 8 year-olds will be based upon developing fundamental gross and fine motor skills that set the stage for success in sport performance later in life. Lead-up games and activities in traditional and non-traditional physical activities will be the primary focus. Campers ages 9 to 12 will experience developmental instruction in softball, volleyball, badminton, football, basketball, floor hockey, ultimate frisbee, swimming, mountain biking, and cooperative games. The emphasis is for campers to develop competent to proficient skills in these activities.

Meals

Campers must bring sack lunches each day. Their lunches will be refrigerated during the morning. Lunches should be packed in paper sacks due to space limitations.

Parent's Night

On Sunday, June 15th, at 6 p.m. in the Activity Center, there will be a "get to know the counselors" night. Parents and campers from all sessions are encouraged to attend. This is a great opportunity to get to know the directors and the counselors that your child will be working with.

Discipline

Our counselors are primarily education professionals and future teachers. If a camper does not display appropriate behavior, the director retains the right to suspend or terminate the child from the camp.

Pre-Camp and Post-Camp

Staff will be available to supervise children during pre and post camp activities from 7:30 – 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 – 5:30 p.m. This is a flat rate regardless if a child stays the entire pre or post-camp. Additionally, guardians who pick up children after 5:30 will be charged a \$10 fee for the first 15 minutes; thereafter, they will be charged \$2.00 per minute. Pre-Camp is \$30.00 per session and Post-Camp is \$45.00 a session.

Camp Registration

Registration applications are due the Friday before the attending session begins, yet space is limited and does not ensure your child a spot until registration and full payment have been received. One application per child is required. All fees must be paid in full on or before the Friday before the camp session begins. We accept payments in the form of cash, check, credit, and debit card.
